In consideration of the local laws no birds will be shot during the competitions.

(FCI Rules International Field Trials for Continental Pointers Art. IV.3 – EC Rules Art. 4.6)

The Judge or the steward will fire a shot with a 9 mm blank pistol if the point and situation is satisfactory. Retrieve of "cold bird" will be at the end of the daily trial only for qualified dogs.

Terrain

The area is totally flat, composed of regular plots divided by ditches. The fields are cultivated with wheat, soy, corn or uncultivated and on the edges there are hedges, trees and bushes.

Game

The game consists mainly of wild pheasants.

It is also possible to find wild partridges or wild quails. The retrieve will be with mallard.

FIELD TRIAL CAC CACIT

Will take place according to EC Magyar Vizsla Rules 2019 that are being approved by the Comitee General FCI https://www.vizslaclub.it/images/EC_2019/EC_regulation_2019.pdf and in reference to FCI Official Rules "Official Rules and Bylaws for International Field Trials and International Hunting Tests for Continental Pointers – Part IV" www.fci.be/en/Continental-Pointers-65.html
Each stake will be judged by 2 Judges possibly of different nationalities.
Each Country may sign up to 2 Teams (1-5 dogs per Team): one shorthaired and one wirehaired or only one mixed Team. Only the results of the best 4 will be taken into account for the final ranking.

DERBY CAC

Will take place according to ENCI Official Rules "Regolamento delle Prove – Verifiche zootecniche per i cani delle Razze da Ferma – Art. 27" <http://www.enci.it/media/5708/regolamento-prove-cani-razze-da-ferma.pdf>
Derby is for dogs up to the age of 30 months on the day.
Each stake will be judged by 1 Judge.
Each Country may sign up to 2 Derby Teams (1-3 dogs per Team): one shorthaired and one wirehaired or only one mixed Team.

DEADLINE - JUNE 15, 2019

1. Each National Vizsla Club must confirm the intention to participate sending an email to segretario@vizslaclub.it informing with how many Teams will be present and the name and email address of each Captain.
The Captains will receive an excel form to be filled in at a later date regarding the attending dogs and handlers.
On request, individuals legally residing in a Country with no Magyar Vizsla Club presence will be granted participation to EC for one or more of their dogs provided that they satisfy the conditions. Participation will be limited to individual classification.
2. The Vizsla Club of the participating Nation that wish to ratify a judge of their nationality must communicate his/her name sending an email to segretario@vizslaclub.it
Judge's accomodation and meal expenses will be offer by us. Not travel expenses, sorry.
The proposed Judge must be qualified to judge at international field trial of continental gun dog to be authorized to judge at the field trials and water retrieve test. Only those special Magyar Vizsla Judges or at least gun dog specialist Judges qualified to judge at international exhibitions of MV can be authorized to judge for breed conformation.

DEADLINE - AUGUST 05, 2019

Every Captain of the National Team must send information about each dog on the Team and pay entry fee for each participating dog.

Entry fees:

- Derby 60 Euro
- Field Trial 120 Euro

Dog datas sending and payment method informations will follow subsequently.
